Slippery path

Please note that with the cold weather the path between the carpark and preschool can become very slippery. Please do take caution as you enter and exit via that path and whilst on the site in general. Please also ensure you pass this on to any other family or friends who might be collecting or dropping your children off.

Family time/experience photo wall

We would love to do a photo area in the preschool home corner of either family time, or experiences the children have had if you would like to send anything in (either printed) or for us to print, of things you've done, who is in your family, favourite pets or things that are special to your child we will put them up. (Please be aware it is a shared space, and these photos will remain out over Noah's ark, Sunday clubs and any other groups or meetings that happen in this space). We will not put names with photos.

Seasonal clothing

As the weather turns colder, please make sure to send some extra layers in addition to the spare clothes sent for your child. We do still offer free flow play inside and out throughout the winter time which means the back door is open for periods of time. Naming hats, gloves and coats in addition to all other items of clothing are really helpful for children being able to identify their own as many children have the same or very similar.

For this term the children now need to wear welly boots in order to play outside to try to prevent the mud coming inside! Please make sure to send your child in their shoes (or non-slip slippers) for inside.

Healthy Eating

A reminder to please not send sweets and chocolates into the preschool as part of the children's snack or lunches. We ask that you limit treats foods to no more than 2 items in addition to the healthy options you provide and at snack only provide rice cakes/breadsticks or fruit/veg. If children do bring sweets or multiple treat foods, we may send these home again.

Last term we enjoyed a shared snack experience which we will be continuing this term, exploring a 'fruit or veg of the week' this is to have alongside their snack, not instead of. The children enjoyed exploring the taste, texture and smell of different foods.

Please ensure small foods such as grapes, cherry tomatoes etc are cut in half or quarters length ways. This is as these foods when not cut can cause a choking hazard.

We have been contacted by a local dentist to book in a visit to preschool around April time to come talk to the children about how to look after our teeth.

Friends and family dropping off

From time to time friends and family drop the children off on a less regular arrangement. Please make sure to make them aware that they must bring your child to the member of staff and hand them over at the white doors rather than leaving them in the entrance room as we may not see they have entered the building.

Funding forms
